AVIATION COURSE OPEN DAY

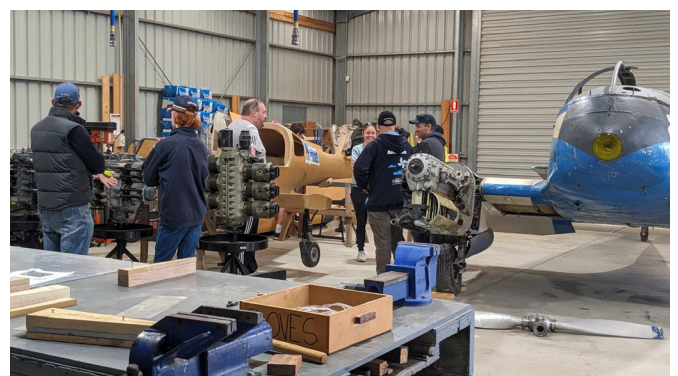
Today we had our annual Aviation Open Day. We opened our doors to many visitors from across the state who showed interest in the Aviation Course we offer here at Mid North Christian College.
