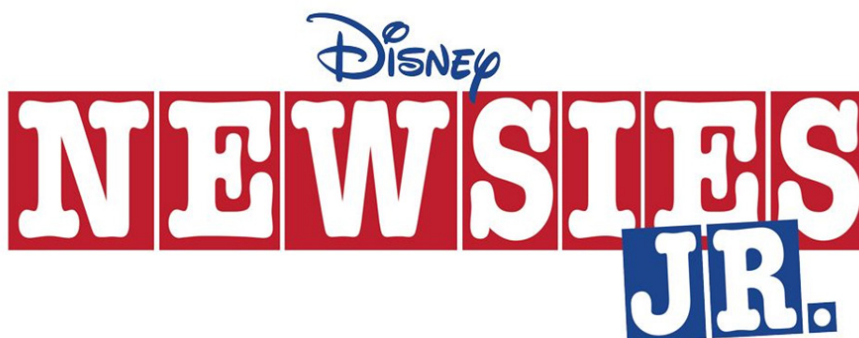
NEWSIES JR TICKETS

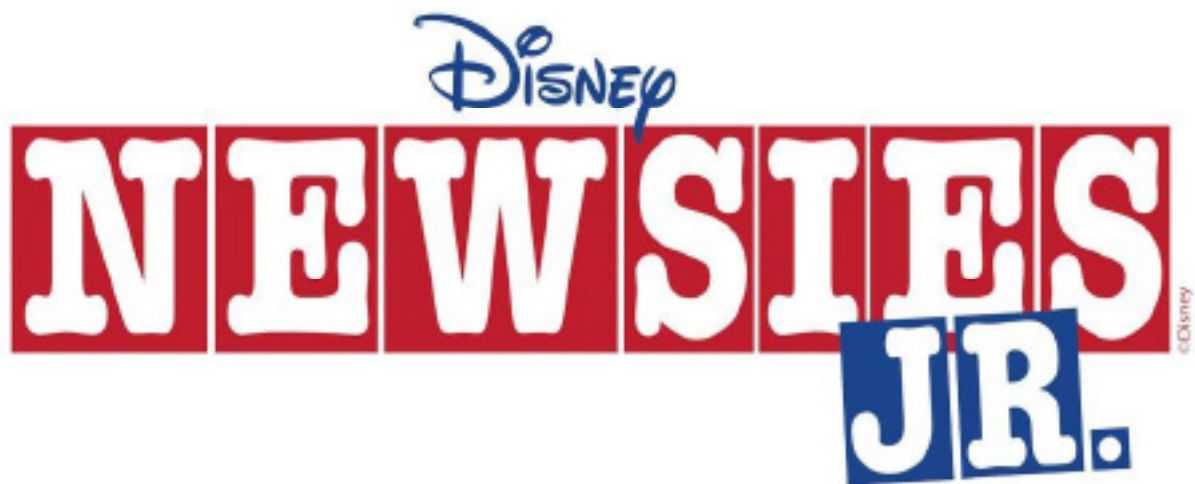
